

Sessions Case No. 86 of 2005

Order No. 145 dated 27. 04. 2017 :-

Today is fixed for further cross-examination of PW-19, IO of this case.

All the accused persons on court bail are present.

Witness, PW-19 (IO) is present.

Ld. PP and Ld. Advocate are present. Ld. Advocate for the accused person submitted that his senior Sri Ganesh Chandra Maiti is sick and he could not conduct the case, today. Ld. PP vehemently opposes.

Perused the record. It shows that the PW-19 is an old aged person and retired from service since long. His evidence was started in the year 2013 and several adjournments have been taken by the defence.

Considering all aspects, it is found that the defence has no intention to complete the present case as it is appears from the trend of cross-examination.

However, for the interest of justice, a single opportunity is given to the Ld. advocate to complete the cross-examination of this witness. It also directed that the alternative advocate may be appoint to complete the cross-examination. No further time will be allowed.

PW-19 is directed to appear on the date fixed at 2 p.m.

Witness is discharged without further examination.
