**Order no. 01 dated 06.03.2026**

1. Ld. PO has been retained on duty in the courts during the upcoming process of Special Intensive Revision (S.I.R.) by the Hon'ble Court, Calcutta in view of the order dated 20.02.2026 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ petition(s) Civil Number(s)1089 of 2025 with W.P. (C) Number-126/2026, W.P. (C) Number-129/2026(PIL-W), W.P. (C) Number-737/2025(PIL-W), W.P. (C) Number-1074/2025 (PIL-W), W.P.(C) Number-1088/2025 (PIL-W), W.P.(C) Number-1216/2025(PIL-W),W.P.(C)Number-159/2026(PIL-W),W.P.(C)Number-119/2026 (PIL-W). I am in charge.
2. Received the original re-registered FIR dated 05.03.2026 filed by the National Investigation Agency.
3. Perused the FIR. Considered.
4. I find that NIA has re-registered a case being no. RC-5/2026/NIA/DLI dated 05.03.2026 under section 303(2) and 317(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, section 9(B)(2) of Explosive Act, 1884 (the then IE Act) and under section 4 & 5 of the Explosive Substances Act against the accused person namely Chandu Let @ Sajal Let.
5. The Court of Ld. Chief Judge, City Sessions Court, Calcutta has been designated as NIA Special Court under section 11 of the National Investigation Agency Act, 2008 by the Hon'ble Court's Notification No. 9586 R (Inspection II) dated 24.11.2010.
6. Accordingly, register the case as NIA Special Case.
7. Today Dy, SP/CIO, NIA, B.O, Kolkata has filed a petition through the Ld. Special Public Prosecutor representing the NIA of the instant case with prayer to pass necessary order -
  - 1) to allow the NIA for filing original of re-registered FIR of NIA case no. RC-5/2026/NIA/DLI,
  - 2) to take cognizance of the re-registered NIA FIR
  - 3) to direct the Superintendent of Police, Birbhum, West Bengal to instruct the concerned Investigating Officer of the Nalhati Police Station case No. 086/2026 dated 14.02.2026 to hand over the original case records, with all exhibits, material objects, documents, alamats, all the

relied/non-relied upon evidence(s). i.e. documentary, expert opinion(s), technical electronic and statements of witnesses etc. to the CIO of NIA of this case being no. RC-5/2026/NIA/DLI.

4) to direct the concerned Investigating Officer of the Nalhati Police Station case No. 086/2026 dated 14.02.2026 to hand over the original case records, with all exhibits, material objects, documents, alams, all the relied/non-relied upon evidence(s). i.e. documentary, expert opinion(s), technical electronic and statements of witnesses etc. to the CIO of NIA of this case being no. RC-5/2026/NIA/DLI.

5) to direct the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate Court, Rampurhat Court for P.S Nalhati to at once transmit the original case records of Nalhati Police Station case No. 086/2026 dated 14.02.2026 before this Court.

6) to direct the Superintendent of Jail, Rampurhat, West Bengal to immediately produce all the arrested accused persons in connection with Nalhati Police Station case No. 086/2026 dated 14.02.2026 before this Court before this Court and

7) to further direct the concerned Investigating Officer to produce the arrested accused persons (if in police custody) before this Court on the date fixed as the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, CTCR Division, North Block, New Delhi as per order bearing no. 11011/20/2026/NIA dated 02.03.2026 has ordered that the case being investigated by the NIA and also prays for passing order for production of the aforesaid accused persons before this court.

8. Ld. Special Public Prosecutor of NIA, Shyamal Ghosh moves the petition.
9. Heard the Special Public Prosecutor of NIA,
10. Perused the petition, Original FIR and the notification of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs and relevant documents.
11. Considering the entire facts and circumstances, the petition filed by the Special Public Prosecutor of NIA is allowed for the ends of justice.
12. Ld. District and Sessions Judge, Birbhum, West Bengal is requested to instruct the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rampurhat to transfer the original judicial record in connection with Nalhati Police Station case No. 086/2026 dated 14.02.2026 and production of the accused before the court of Ld. Chief Judge, City Sessions Court, Calcutta, Bichar Bhawan, 2 & 3, Bankshall Street, Kolkata- 700 001 which is the special Court designated to try the offences under the NIA Act.
13. The Superintendent of Police, Birbhum, West Bengal and the Investigating Officer of Nalhati Police Station case No. 086/2026 dated 14.02.2026 are directed to hand over all the original case diaries, material objects and articles seized in connection with this case along with expert opinion(s), technical, electronic and statements of witnesses etc. to the Investigating Officer of NIA appointed to investigate the instant case in the meantime positively.

14. Let a copy of this order along with a letter of request be forwarded to the Ld. District and Sessions Judge, Birbhum, West Bengal for information and giving necessary direction to the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rampurhat to take necessary step for transferring the original judicial record in connection with Nalhati Police Station case No. 086/2026 dated 14.02.2026 and production of the accused before the Ld. Chief Judge (Special Court, NIA), City Sessions Court, Calcutta on the next date i.e. on **20.03.2026**.
15. Let a copy of this order be sent to the Superintendent of Police, Birbhum, West Bengal to instruct the concerned Investigating Officer of the Nalhati Police Station case No. 086/2026 dated 14.02.2026 for necessary compliance.
16. Let a copy of this order also be given to the Ld. Special Public Prosecutor of NIA, Shyamal Ghosh so that he may process the matter keeping in mind the exigency of the instant case.
17. Let a copy of this order be sent to the Investigating Officer of Nalhati Police Station case No. 086/2026 dated 14.02.2026 for necessary compliance.
18. Let a copy of this order be also given to the Investigating Officer, NIA as prayed for.
19. Fix **20.03.2026** for taking steps, submitting report, Production of the accused persons and further order.
