1. Today is fixed for hearing of the petition on the point of admission.
2. Ld. Advocate for the appellants is present by filing hazira.
3. It appears that the appellants have filed the instant memo of appeal challenging the order and judgement dated 03.01.2026 passed by the Ld. 20th Judicial Magistrate, Calcutta in connection with Complaint Case no. CS/121633 of 2022.
4. The memo of appeal is filed within the statutory period of limitation. So there is no legal bar or impediment to admit the instant appeal. Accordingly, the instant appeal is admitted **subject to the condition that the appellant shall deposit 20% of the compensation amount of Rs. 18,00,000/- before the Ld. Trial Court within 02.06.2026.**
5. Ld. Advocate for the appellants filed an application for staying the operation of the impugned order and judgement dated 03.01.2026 passed by the Ld. Judicial Magistrate, 20th Court, Calcutta in connection with Complaint Case no. CS/121633/2022.

7. On careful perusal of the order and judgement dated 03.01.2026 passed by the Ld. Trial Court it appears to me that the appellant has an arguable case. Therefore, if the operation of the impugned order and judgement dated 03.01.2026 is not stayed, then the appellant will be highly prejudiced.
8. The prayer for staying the operation of the order and judgement dated 03.01.2026 passed by the Ld. Judicial Magistrate, 20th Court, Calcutta in connection with Complaint Case no. CS/121633/2022 is allowed for ends of justice.
9. The operation of the order and judgement dated 03.01.2026 passed by the Ld. Judicial Magistrate, 20th Court, Calcutta in connection with Complaint Case no. CS/121633/2022 is stayed till next date (**02.06.2026**).
10. Issue notice upon respondent no.2/The State of West Bengal in usual manner and upon the respondent No.1 through court as well as registered post with A/D.
11. The appellants to file requisites at once.
12. Call for TCR.
13. Fixing **02.06.2026** for S.R, A.D and appearance and for filing receipt of showing deposit of 20% of the compensation amount before the Ld. Trial Court.
14. Let a copy of this order be sent to Ld. Trial Court for information.
