**Order no. 207 dated 07.05.2025**

The record is put up today by petition.

Accused **Pradeep Pradhan @ Bhupendra Pradhan** surrenders before this Court by filing petition. He is taken into custody and remanded to J.C till 20.05.2025.

By filing a petition the accused/petitioner **Pradeep Pradhan @ Bhupendra Pradhan** prays for bail and he also submitted copy of the order of the Hon'ble Court.

The relevant portion of the order of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta vide CRR 1365 of 2025 runs as follows :

*"It appears that the petitioner had been attending court since 2020 and was absent on one occasion in 2025 when the warrant of arrest was issued. In view of the above and the interest of justice, the warrant of arrest issued against the petitioner shall remain stayed for a period of five week from this date. The petitioner shall be at liberty to appear before the trial court and pray for bail. In the event the petitioner surrenders before the trial court and prays for bail within such time of five weeks from this date, his application shall be considered in accordance with law. Accordingly, the revisional application is disposed of".*

Ld. Advocate appearing for the accused/petitioner submits that on 03.03.2025 the accused person failed to appear before the Court due to reception party/marriage of his daughter dated 02.03.2025 at Diamond Gold Resort, Manigram, Nepal. He further submits that the said matter was reported to the Ld. Court.

I have carefully perused the order dated 03.03.2025 and from that order of this Court it appears that on 03.03.2025 the Ld. Advocate representing the accused **Pradeep Pradhan @ Bhupendra Pradhan** by filing a petition submits that this accused/petitioner could not be able to appear before this Court due to the marriage/reception party of his daughter on 02.03.2025.

Ld. P.P raises objection.

It appears from the Hon'ble Court's order that the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta has been pleased to observe that the warrant of arrest against the accused/petitioner shall remain stayed for a period of five week from this day i.e. on 02.05.2025.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and in view of the observation of the Hon'ble Court and the grounds for which the accused/petitioner has failed to appear before this Court on 03.03.2025, I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail.

The accused/petitioner namely **Pradeep Pradhan @ Bhupendra Pradhan** may find bail of **Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only)**, with two sureties of **Rs. 5,000/- each** (out of which one must be local) (other than previous sureties) subject to the satisfaction of Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Calcutta with a condition that he shall present before this Court on each and every date fixed for trial.

This order shall remain in force till **20.05.2025**.

If the accused person availed of the opportunity of bail, to date (**20.05.2025**) for appearance of the accused/petitioner in default production.

Let a copy of this order be sent to the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Calcutta for information and necessary compliance.
