1. Ld. PO has been retained on duty in the courts during the upcoming process of Special Intensive Revision (S.I.R.) by the Hon'ble Court, Calcutta in view of the order dated 20.02.2026 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ petition(s) Civil Number(s)1089 of 2025 with W.P. (C) Number-126/2026, W.P. (C) Number-129/2026(PIL-W), W.P. (C) Number-737/2025(PIL-W), W.P. (C) Number-1074/2025 (PIL-W), W.P.(C) Number-1088/2025 (PIL-W), W.P.(C) Number-1216/2025(PIL-W), W.P.(C) Number-159/2026(PIL-W), W.P.(C)Number-119/2026 (PIL-W). I am in charge.
2. Today is fixed for hearing of application u/s 483(1)(b) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed by accused/petitioner, namely, **Rajesh Kumar Singh**, praying for relaxing/waiving/modifying the condition of order dated 14.01.2026 passed in Criminal Misc. Case no. 206 of 2025 passed by this Ld. Court in connection with **Shakespeare Sarani P.S** case no. **125** dated 22.08.2025 arising out of GR(S) case no. **773 of 2025** under section **318(3)/336(2)/338** of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.
3. The record is taken up for hearing.
4. Ld. Chief Public Prosecutor as well as Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner are present.
5. I.O is also present with C.D.
6. Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner submitted that this court has been pleased to grant bail in respect of the accused/petitioner on 14.01.2026 in connection with Criminal Misc. Case no. 206 of 2026 with a condition *that the accused/petitioner is further directed to meet with the Investigating Officer twice in a week for the purpose of investigation* along with other conditions.
7. Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner further submitted that this accused/petitioner has complied with all the conditions as imposed by this Ld. Court at the time of granting bail. He further submits that this accused/petitioner is the resident of Bihar and it is very much difficult for him to come twice in a week before the Investigating Officer due to the issues relating to health. So, he prays for passing necessary order.
8. Ld. Chief Public Prosecutor submits that there is no such adverse report against the accused/petitioner after granting bail and he has complied all the conditions as imposed by this court at the time of granting bail and he leaves the matter to the discretion of this court.
9. I have carefully perused the case record and the materials appearing in the case diary.
10. On careful perusal of the case diary and the materials available on the record, it appears that he has complied with all the conditions of bail passed by this Court on 14.01.2026 in connection with Criminal Misc. Case being no. 206 of 2026 till today and there is no adverse report against this accused/petitioner.
11. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to modify/relax the condition of bail i.e. **the accused/petitioner is directed to meet with the Investigating Officer once in a week for the purpose of investigation** instead of twice in a week for the purpose of investigation.

12. The other conditions remain unaltered.

13. Misc. case is disposed of.

14. C.D & TCR be returned.
