Today is fixed for hearing of the petition u/s 5 of the Limitation Act *ex parte* in respect of the Opposite Party no. 1 afresh.

Ld. Advocates for revisionist and OP no. 2 & 3 are present.

Now, the record is taken up for hearing of the petition u/s 5 of the Limitation Act.

Ld. Advocate for revisionist has prayed for condonation of delay on any terms and condition and submitted that due to his hospitalization, it was not possible for him to file the instant revision within the stipulated period.

Ld. Advocate for OP no. 2 opposed the prayer of the revisionist.

Heard. Perused the entire case record.

On bare reading of the prayer for condonation of delay, it seems that due to his hospitalization for his old age related ailments and since there is no one to look after him, there is an unintentional delay in filing the instant revision within the stipulated period.
