Order No. 04 dated 08.04.2026

1. In this criminal Misc. case under section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 the accused/petitioner namely, **Aman Chaurasia** who apprehends his arrest in connection with **Burtolla** Police Station case no. **19** dated **10.02.2026** under sections **281/106(1)/106(2)/54 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023** has come up with a prayer for grant of anticipatory bail.
2. At the very outset, Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner submits that no application for anticipatory bail has either been rejected by the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta or is pending for disposal before the Hon'ble Court.
3. Ld. Advocate draws my attention to the paragraph No. 03 of the application under section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita relating to such fact.
4. Ld. Chief Public Prosecutor submits that there is no indication in the case diary which goes to suggest that prayer for anticipatory bail for the accused/petitioner has either been rejected by the Hon'ble High Court or is pending before the Hon'ble Court for disposal.
5. Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner prays for anticipatory bail on the grounds that -
 - (a) the allegations made in the complainant and the FIR are totally false, frivolous and baseless;
 - (b) he is no way connected with the alleged offence in question;
 - (c) he has cooperated with the investigation and
 - (d) he has fixed place of residence and there is no chance of his absconsion.
6. Ld. Chief Public Prosecutor opposes the anticipatory bail prayer of the accused/petitioner.
7. I have carefully perused the case record and the materials appearing in the case diary.
8. Considering the materials appearing in the Case Diary, I am of the view that custodial interrogation of the accused/petitioner is not necessary.
9. Thus, I am inclined to allow the prayer for anticipatory bail of the accused/petitioner.
10. Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of this accused/petitioner is **allowed**.
11. In the event of arrest, the accused/petitioner namely **Aman Chaurasia** be enlarged on bail of **Rs. 5,000/-** with two sureties of **Rs. 2,500/- each** to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer subject to the condition as enumerated in section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a condition that he shall appear before the jurisdictional Court and pray for regular bail within a period of four weeks from date.
12. Case diary be returned at once.
13. Misc. Case is disposed of.
14. Let a copy of this order along with the TCR be sent to the Court concerned.
15. Let a copy of this order be also sent to the I.O through Ld. Chief Public Prosecutor for information.
