Order no. 134 dated 29.02.2024

To-day is fixed for production of both the Accused persons from J.C. before this Court and further cross-examination of P.W.-17, Susanta Dhar.

Both the Accused nos.(A-1) and (A-2) are produced from J.C.

Ld. Counsel for the Accused persons is present.

Ld. Special P. Ps. are present by filing hazira.

P.W.-17, Susanta Dhar is present in Court. In presence of both sides the record is taken up for recording evidence.

At this juncture, Ld. Counsel for the accused persons draws attention of this Court to the deposition of P.W.17 namely Susanta Dhar dated 03.07.2023 and submits that a typographical mistake has crept in the first part of the deposition of P.W.17 dated 03.07.2023 to the extent that "Examination-in-chief of P.W.1 begins today i.e. on 03.07.2023" which should be read as "Examination-in-chief of **P.W.17** begins today i.e. on 03.07.2023" and therefore it is prayed for rectifying the typographical error caused inadvertently.

Ld. P.P.-in-charge submits that this is just a typographical mistake and submits that he has no objection to rectifying the same typographical error.

Heard the Ld. Counsels for both sides.

Perused the deposition of P.W.17 namely Susanta Dhar dated 03.07.2023.

It is found that due to inadvertence a typographical mistake has occurred in the deposition sheet of P.W.17 namely Susanta Dhar dated 03.07.2023 with regard to the number of the Prosecution witness and the same is a mere typographical and clerical error which has occurred due to inadvertence and moreover on the format portion it was rightly typed as "the Deposition of Prosecution Witness No.17 aged about 61 years, taken on oath or solemn affirmation before me"

In view of such fact, the deposition of P.W.17 namely Susanta Dhar dated 03.07.2023 be rectified as "Examination-in-chief of **P.W.17** begins today i.e. on 03.07.2023" in place of Examination-in-chief of **P.W.1** begins today i.e. on 03.07.2023.

The Bench Clerk to do the needful.

P.W.-17, Susanta Dhar is further cross-examined by the Ld. Defence Counsel **in part**.

At this juncture, a petition has been filed by the Ld. Defense Counsel praying for an adjournment on the ground stated therein.

Heard both sides on the point of adjournment.

Prayer for adjournment is considered and allowed.

As per Gazette Notification dated 15.07.2022, the certified true copy of the deposition of P.W-17 dated 29.02.2024 is handed over to both sides i.e. the prosecution as well as the Ld. Defence Counsel after obtaining endorsement in the relevant register.

Continued order no.134 dated 29.02.2024

On submission of both sides, fix **04.04.2024** for production of both the Accused persons from J.C. before this Court and further cross-examination of P.W.-17, Susanta Dhar.

Re-issue summon in the name of P.W.-17, Susanta Dhar with a direction to remain present before this Court on the date fixed for adducing further evidence.

Both the Accused persons are remanded to J.C. till 04.04.2024.
