Ld. Counsel for the revisionist is present.

Now, the record is taken up for hearing on the point of admission.

At this stage, Ld. Advocate for the revisionist files one petition praying for adjournment on the ground that the copy of the section 5 application has not been served.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the revisionist.

Perused the record.

On perusal of the record it appears that the revisionist filed the instant revision on 06.04.2026 against the impugned order dated 08.01.2026 passed by the Ld. Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Calcutta in connection with GDE no.207 dated 03.09.2025, NCRP ACK no.33208250063857 dated 10.08.2025.

As per the Limitation Act the statutory period of filing of revision is 90 days from the date of passing of the order of the Ld. Trial Court and here in this case it appears that the section 5 of Limitation Act does not attract. Moreover, no application for condonation of delay is filed by the revisionist/petitioner at all.

In view of the above facts and circumstances, the petition filed by the revisionist today becomes infructuous and so the petition filed today stands rejected.
