Perused the Certified Copy of order dated 11.01.2023 of Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta in connection with C.R. M. (DB) 4490 of 2022 wherein the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta has been pleased to pass an order to that effect that:

“Accordingly, the petitioner viz., Sk. Rejaul @ Kiran @ Rutu shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.25,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judge, City Sessions Court, Calcutta subject to condition that he shall appear before the trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever and on further condition that the petitioner while on bail shall not remain within the municipal limits of the city of Kolkata and shall provide the address where he shall presently reside to the Investigating Agency as well as the court below and shall report to the Officer-in-charge of the police station within whose jurisdiction he shall presently reside once in a week until further orders.

In the event the petitioner fails to appear before the Trial Court without any justifiable cause, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

The application for bail, thus, stands allowed.”

In view of the order dated 11.01.2023 of Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta in connection with C.R. M. (DB) 4490 of 2022, the Accused **(A-20), Sk. Rejaul @ Kiran @ Rutu** be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.25,000/- **(Rupees Twenty five thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local** to the satisfaction of this Court on condition that he shall strictly comply with above mentioned the order of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.
