Today is fixed for hearing bail petition dated 19.12.2022 and 06.03.2022 in respect of accused no. A-4 Paigambar Sk. and A-14 Abdul Matin

Heard Ld. Advocate for the accused as well as Ld. Public Prosecutor.

Ld. Advocates for the accused persons submit that accused person is having no role to play in this case and he is tagged with the Buddha Gaya Bomb Blast case and for such reason he cannot be convicted twice because of the provision u/s 300 of the Cr.P.C.

Huge explosives appears to have been recovered from his possession and several charges are labeled against Accused no. 4.

So far bail of Accused no. 14 Abdul Matin is concerned, on the basis of statement of Accused no. 4 he was arrested as having conspiracy with him to shaken the sovereignty of the State. It is not an individual Act but it is a matter of larger conspiracy for throwing the Government with their terrorist activities act.

Ld. P.P submits that when Buddha Gaya Bomb Blast case was at the fag end of trial, this incident occurred and the time, place and recovery are having no close proximity as claimed by Accused no. 4.

Considering the involvement of the accused persons in commission of the offence as charged, the question of granting bail of these two accused persons does not arise and the bail applications dated dated 19.12.2022 and 06.03.2022 in respect of accused no. A-4 Paigambar Sk. and A-14 Abdul Matin as such are rejected.
