

Paljindra Singh Vs. PSPCL etc. 568.18.

Present: Sh. Shivdeep Mehta, Advocate counsel for plaintiff.

Suit received by way of entrustment. Report of Reader is seen. It be checked and registered. Summon of suit against defendants be issued for 14.12.2018, upon filing of process fee and copies of plaint.

Along with suit, plaintiff has moved an application under order 39 rule 1 and 2 read with Section 151 C.P.C. for grant of ad-interim injunction against defendants for restraining forever from disconnecting the electric meter bearing its account No. T12GT120056X in the name of defendant No.4 and installed and running over property measuring 18 Marlas over which 4 shops, open space, upstairs etc. interfering in the peaceful possession of the plaintiff forcibly, illegally or in any way and defendants be also restrained forever from disconnecting the said electric meter of plaintiffs forcibly and illegally or in any way from the suit land. The contention of plaintiffs are supported by affidavit to this effect. In support of their prima facie case, plaintiff has also produced on record attested photocopy of Stay order dated 14.11.2018, Photocopy of electricity bills of various dates from 29.08.2014 to 12.04.2018, photocopy of receipt of PSPCL No.220306, Photocopy of application of SDO, Bhikhiwind, with postal receipt, colored photo of electricity Box.

After hearing the arguments of learned counsel for the plaintiff and going through the contents of the application and documents placed on the file, this Court considers that prima facie case is made out in favour of plaintiff and balance of convenience in their favour. In order to maintain ends of justice. Both the parties are directed to maintain status quo of electric meter bearing its account No. T12GT120056X in the name of defendant No.4, as described detailed in the head note of plaint, till date fixed.

Compliance under Order 39 Rule 3 CPC be made forthwith. Plaintiff will get served defendants at their own responsibility by taking dasti summons. In case defendants are not get served in the said manner, then status quo order shall be deemed to be vacated without any further order to this effect on the adjourned date. Notice of the present application be also issued to defendants for date fixed. Dasti process may be given if requested.
