An application has been moved by Officer incharge of Police Station Tripuri for shifting of case properties as mentioned in the application from S.No.1 to 9 from the Judicial Malkhana, Patiala to Centralized Malkhana, Police Lines, Patiala. A letter written by Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala bearing letter no.45864/C3 dated 22.09.2022 to Ld. District & Sessions Judge, Patiala was also received to this court wherein Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala has informed that Centralized Malkhana has been set up at Police Lines, Patiala for storing the bulk case properties relating to Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances. Now copy of letter bearing No.7520 dated 27.09.2022 addressed to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala by Ld. District & Sessions Judge, Patiala also received to this court wherein direction has been issued to Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to make appropriate applications before Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patiala i.e. this court for shifting of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances bulk cases properties from Judicial Malkhana, Patiala to Centralized Malkhana situated at Police Lines, Patiala immediately. Hence in compliance to the direction of Ld. District & Sessions Judge, Patiala and since the Centralized Malkhana has been set up at Police Lines, Patiala and as per report of Malkhana Nazir the case properties mentioned at S.No.1 to 4 and from S.No.6 to 9 is lying deposited in the Judicial Malkhana, Patiala to be shifted/taken away from the Judicial Malkhana, Patiala. As per report of officials of P.S. Tripuri dated 19.10.2022, the case property of case FIR No.185 dated 09.07.2022 mentioned at S.No.5 is inadvertently mentioned in application. Hence application is allowed, Malkhana Nazir is directed to hand over the bulk case properties mentioned at S.No.1 to 4 and from S.No.6 to 9 to the incharge of Police Station concerned against proper receipt and verification. The case properties be shifted under the supervision of Gazetted Officer holding the prescribed rank/designation. The Officer incharge of Police Station Tripuri is also directed to furnish compliance certificate regarding shifting of case properties within a period of 15 days. Necessary entry be made in the relevant register. File be consigned.
