Today is fixed for hearing of an application u/s 482 of the BNSS, 2023 filed by accused/petitioner namely, **Saraj Mukherjee** praying for anticipatory bail in connection with **Bowbazar** P.S. case No. **99** dated **07.06.2026** u/s **115(2)/126(2)/3(5)/351(2)/61(2)/62/74/76** of the BNS, 2023.

Ld. Chief Public Prosecutor and Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner are present.

I.O is present with the case diary.

Now the record is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner submits that this accused/petitioner is innocent and has been falsely entangled in this case and he is no way connected with the alleged offence. He further submits that the matter of dispute by and between the parties has been amicably settled. So, he prays for anticipatory bail of this accused/petitioner.

It is submitted by Ld. advocate for the accused/petitioner that no bail petition is pending/disposed before/by any upper forum.

Ld. Chief Public Prosecutor submits that complainant had sent a letter to the I.O of this case that the matter of dispute has been amicably settled between the parties and that letter is lying in the C.D. So, he prays for passing necessary order.

Heard. Perused the case record and the other materials available in the case diary.

Considering the nature of allegations, injury report and the other materials available in the case diary, it does not appear that custodial interrogation of the accused/petitioner would be needed for the purpose of investigation.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the accused/petitioner **Saraj Mukherjee** is **allowed**.

In the event of arrest, the accused/petitioner **Saraj Mukherjee** shall be released on furnishing a bond of Rs. **5,000/-** with two sureties of **Rs. 2,500/- each** subject to the satisfaction of the arresting authority.

On being released the accused/petitioner is also directed to comply with the provision laid down 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

The instant criminal misc. case is thus disposed of.
