Order no. 04 dated 30.04.2026

1. Today is fixed for production of the accused persons.
2. Accused persons, namely, Akramul Bagani and Mofakkerul Islam are produced from J/C through audio-video electronic means.
3. Ld. Special Public Prosecutor representing the NIA is present.
4. Ld. Advocate representing the accused persons is present today.
5. Ld. Advocate for accused persons Akramul Bagani and Mofakkerul Islam has filed a bail petition and submits that accused Mofakkerul Islam is a practising Advocate of the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta and accused Akramul Bagani is a journalist. He further submits that they have been falsely implicated in this case and they are not FIR named accused. He further submits that they are in no way connected with the alleged offence and they are in custody for about 27 days. So, he prays for bail.
6. Ld. Special Public Prosecutor representing the NIA raises vehement objection against the bail prayer of the accused stating that they are directly involved in this case and investigation is going on in full swing. He further submits that if they are liberated on bail at this stage, the investigation will be hampered. So, he prays for rejection of the bail prayer made on behalf of accused persons.
7. It appears that the accused persons were arrested in connection with Kaliachak PS Case no. 462 of 2026 dated 02.04.2026 under Section 126(2)/221/189(1)/49/61(2)/285 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 read with Section 18 of the West Bengal Highways Act and Section 9 of the Maintenance of Public Order Act.
8. Considering the gravity of the offences, the ramifications on national security, and the early stage of the investigation, a thorough probe is manifestly required to unearth the larger conspiracy behind the alleged incident, which pertains to the country's internal security, I am not inclined to allow the prayer for bail of the accused persons at this stage.
9. Ld. Special Public Prosecutor has filed a petition praying for judicial custody of the accused for thorough and proper investigating of this case.
10. Heard. Considered. The prayer is allowed in the interest of investigation.
11. Accordingly, the accused persons Akramul Bagani and Mofakkerul Islam be remanded to J/C till 14.05.2026.
12. Fix **14.05.2026** for production of the accused from the J/C.
13. Let a copy of this order be sent to the Investigating Officer through the Ld. Special Public Prosecutor for information.
