Today is fixed for hearing of an application u/s 482 of the BNSS, 2023 filed by accused/petitioners namely, **1) Md. Altamas Nadeem** and **2) Farhan Akhtar** praying for anticipatory bail in connection with **South Port** P.S. case No. **46** dated **11.04.2026** u/s **118(1)/126(2)/54/351(2)** of the BNS, 2023.

Ld. Chief Public Prosecutor and Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioners are present.

I.O is present with the case diary.

Now the record is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioners submits that they are totally innocent, have been falsely implicated in this case, nothing has been recovered from their possession and they are no way involved in this case. So, he prays for anticipatory bail of the accused/petitioners.

It is submitted by Ld. advocate for the accused/petitioners that no bail petition is pending/disposed before/by any upper forum.

Ld. Chief Public Prosecutor leaves the matter upon the discretion of this Court by submitting that there was a hot altercation by and between the parties for which the defacto complainant received injuries and thereafter he was treated and discharge from the hospital on the date of incident.

Heard. Perused the case record and the case diary.

Haring regard to the submission of both sides and considering the materials available in the case diary vis-a-vis the injury report, this Court finds that custodial interrogation of the accused/petitioner is not required.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the accused/petitioners **1) Md. Altamas Nadeem** and **2) Farhan Akhtar** is **allowed**.

In the event of arrest, the accused/petitioners **1) Md. Altamas Nadeem** and **2) Farhan Akhtar** shall be released on furnishing a bond of Rs. **5,000/- each** with two sureties of **Rs.2,500/- each** subject to the satisfaction of the arresting authority.

On being released the accused/petitioners are also directed to comply with the provision laid down 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

The instant criminal misc. case is thus disposed of.
