Today is fixed for production of the sole accused person who is on C.B. in this case either in physical mode or in virtual mode and hearing of the petition dated 25.09.2023 filed on behalf of the accused person praying for dropping the proceedings of the instant case in view of the Judgment and decision passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Bikramjit Singh's case (2022(10) SCC 616) and filing Vakalatnama on behalf of the accused person.

The sole accused person who is on C.B. in this case is produced before this Court from J.C. in virtual mode.

Received one report from the Superintendent of Alipore Women's Correctional Home communicated vide office letter no.778/AB dated 02.03.2024 regarding non production of the accused person before this Court.

As the accused person has been produced in virtual mode from the Central Correctional Home, Guwahati, Assam, let the same be kept with the record.

The accused person is identified by the Authority of the Central Correctional Home, Guwahati, Assam and the accused person submits that she could hear everything with regard to the Court proceedings clearly without any technical glitch.

Ld. Counsel for the accused person as well as the Ld. Special P.P. are present.

The petition dated 25.09.2023 filed on behalf of the accused person prayed for dropping the proceedings of the instant case in view of the Judgment passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Bikramjit Singh's case (2022(10) SCC 616) is taken up for hearing.

At this juncture, a petition has been filed by the Ld. Counsel for the accused person stating that the senior Ld. Counsel who was conducting the instant case has expired and the brief and the documents of the case have been received from the family members of the said deceased Ld. Counsel and the accused person is now detained in Central Correctional Home, Guwahati, Assam in connection with NIA Case and as such Ld. Counsel is unable to file Vakalatnama today as signature of the accused person could not be taken as yet and therefore it is prayed for some time to file Vakalatnama on the next date fixed with a further prayer for an adjournment on the ground stated therein.

Heard the Ld. Counsel for the accused person and the Ld. Special P.P.

Prayer for adjournment is considered and allowed for the ends of justice.

On submission of the Ld. Counsel for the accused person, fix **09.04.2024** for production of the sole accused person who is on C.B. in this case either in physical mode or in virtual mode and hearing of the petition dated 25.09.2023 filed on behalf of the accused person praying for dropping the proceedings of the instant case in view of the Judgment and decisions passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Bikramjit Singh's case (2022(10) SCC 616) and filing Vakalatnama on behalf of the accused person.
