Today is fixed for hearing of bail petition dated 12. 12. 2024 on behalf of accused namely, Ajay Das. Another bail petition is filed today on behalf of accused, namely Amitabha Saha.

All the accused persons are produced from judicial custody and placed on dock.

Ld. PP is present. Ld. Advocate for the accused persons are present.

Bail petitions dated 12. 12. 2024 and 12. 02. 2025 are taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate on behalf of accused persons submitted that the accused are languishing in custody since a long time. Ld. Advocate on behalf of accused Ajay Das submitted that the accused has never moved before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta and that since most of the witnesses have already been examined, there is no chance of tampering with the evidence.

Continuation of order No. 35 dated 12. 02. 2025 :-

Ld. Advocate on behalf of accused Amitabha Saha submitted that the accused moved before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta and his prayer for bail was rejected.

Ld. PP raised vehement objection.

I perused the bail application, CD and other materials on record.

This is a case under Section 302/34 of Indian Penal Code and the evidence of PW-14 is concluded. The prosecution has yet few witnesses to be examined.

Considering that bail petition of accused Amitabha Saha has already been rejected by Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta and considering the nature and gravity of offences and stage of trial and materials in CD, I am not inclined to enlarge the accused persons on bail.

Hence, prayer for bail of accused persons, namely, Ajay Das and Amitabha Saha stands rejected.
