Record is put up today by a petition filed on behalf of the accused persons namely (ii) Manobrata Jana and (iii) Balai Charan Maity.

By filing another petition along with a copy of order dated 17.09.2025 passed by the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta in connection with CRA (DB) 51 of 2025 in IA no.CRAN/2/2025 stating that in compliance with the direction of the Hon'ble Court the accused person namely Manobrata Jana will be residing at Village-Naruabilla, P.O. Bamanbarh, Naruya Billa, Purba Medinipur, West Bengal-721456 and the accused person namely Balai Charan Maity will be residing at Nijnaruya, Analberia, Nilnarua, Purba Medinipur, Analberia, West Bengal-721444 and therefore the Ld. Counsel prays for taking note of the present place of residence of the accused persons.

Perused the copy of order dated 17.09.2025 wherein the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta has been pleased to observe as follows:

“In such circumstances, we relax the conditions of bail as prayed for by the appellants.

Conditions 8 (i) the petitioners shall remain within the jurisdiction of New Town Police Station, Rajarhat, Kolkata, excepting for the purpose of attending Court proceedings, (ii) the petitioners shall meet the Bench Clerk of the Chief Judge, City Sessions Court, Calcutta during office hours twice in a week until further order, and the concerned Bench clerk will record the attendance of each of the petitioners separately with endorsement and official seal, in the attendance registers to be produced by the petitioners and (iii) the petitioners shall furnish their local addresses where they will reside presently to the I.O. of this case as well to the Learned Trial Court are relaxed. All other conditions will remain the same.

Appellants will submit the details of their place of residence subsequently to the relaxation, with the jurisdictional Court within a fortnight from date. Appellants shall be present in Court on every date fixed.

CRAN/2/2025 is disposed of.”

Let the copy of the solemn order dated 17.09.2025 passed by the Hon'ble Court along with the petition filed today be kept with the record.
