**ORDER**

1. By this order, this Court intends to dispose off the present bail application under Section 439 Cr.PC having been filed by

applicant Rahul Kumar.

2. This FIR has been registered on the statement of complainant Sumit Phutela with the allegations that on 17.08.2021 while he was returning back home on foot after closing down his shop of denting and painting of vehicle. It was about 8.00 PM when he reached under the Hanumangarh Railway Over bridge and was crossing the lines, three persons already standing in dark to whom he can identify if produced before him, snatched bag from his possession which was containing a Laptop of Dell company, his apple i phone was also snatched by the said assailants and after committing such crime they fled away from there. It was on 19.08.2021 that on again seeing two of the assailants in the area of Railway Crossing falling on the way to the house of complainant he identified them as assailants and also given their description in the FIR. During the course of investigation applicant was arrested and snatched i phone recovered from his possession.

3. Notice of the bail application was served upon the State through learned Additional PP alongwith copy of bail application, who received the same, appeared and contested the bail application on merits. Police record was requisitioned which has been received and

perused.

4. I have heard the respective contentions of both the learned Advocates and have perused the record with their able assistance.

5. This application for regular bail has been filed by the applicant primarily on the ground that the investigation of the case has been completed and that no useful purpose shall be served by keeping him behind the bars. This Court has carefully considered such submissions of learned counsel for the applicant. Even though the investigation of this case is stated to have been completed but even at this stage this Court does not deem it appropriate to grant bail to the applicant-accused as his release on bail at this stage likely to adversely affect the examination of material witnesses in view of the seriousness of allegations

6. Resultantly, the bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. filed by applicant/accused stands dismissed being without merits. Police record be returned and the bail application file be consigned to the record room.
