ORDER PASSED BELOW EXH.1
IN CIVIL MISC. APPLICATION NO.104/2025

Application is filed under the Rule VIII of the Bombay Regulation Act, 1827.

2. The applicant Gayabai Ramdas Aglave and Sunil Ramdas Aglave filed present application. During pendency of matter they moved application below Exh. 11 and added daughters of deceased Ramdas Namdev Aglave namely Anita Ashok Tupe, Karuna Sahebrao Dhanvate and Savita Kishor Pathe to the present application as per order of this court.

3. The applicants are desirous of having their right formally recognized as legal heirs of deceased namely Ramdas Namdev Aglave who expired on 28.08.2017.

4. Applicants contended that, Ramdas Namdev Aglave is Husband of the applicant No. 1 and Father of Applicant No. 2 to 5. Applicants requires heirship Certificate for Governmental and Non-Governmental purpose and for registration their name in RTO Office in respect of vehicle of the deceased. There is no any

other legal heirs to the above said deceased except applicants. Therefore, they requires Heirship Certificate.

4. Accordingly, this Court issued proclamation through citation notice and public notice in daily newspaper "Sarvamat" dated 30.01.2026 circulated locally calling upon objections of all the person who disputes the rights of applicants. So also notices of this application were posted on the conspicuous portion of Tahsildar Office and Court.

5. Till today no sufficient objection is offered by anyone.

6. Applicants have contented that they are legal heirs of deceased and except them there are no other legal heirs. In support of their contention they have filed Verified Copy of Death Certificate of deceased Ramdas Namdev Aglave at (Exh. 8). Xerox Copy of Aadhar Card of Applicant Nos. 1 & 2.

7. Applicant No. 2 filed his evidence on record in form of affidavit in lieu of examination-in-chief.

8. After considering the application, evidence of applicant No. 2 and documents filed on record and fact that none has objected rights of applicants, the applicants being wife, son and daughters are legal heirs of deceased Ramdas Namdev Aglave therefore, this Court is satisfied that there is no hurdle in granting

Heirship Certificate in the name of applicants. Hence, following order is passed.

ORDER

1	Application is allowed.
2	Applicant Nos. 1) Gayabai Ramdas Aglave, 2) Sunil Ramdas Aglave, 3) Anita Ashok Tupe, 4) Karuna Sahebrao Dhanvate and 5) Savita Kishor Pathe are formally recognized as heirs of the deceased namely Ramdas Namdev Aglave.
3	Issue Certificate of Heirship in form Appendix-B in the names of applicants on payment of requisite court fees.
4	Case and proceedings stands disposed off accordingly.
