Order no. 24 dated 15.12.2025

1. Today is fixed for production of the accused persons, further cross examination of PW-12 and hearing of the petition u/s 311 of Code of Criminal Procedure.
2. Accused persons, namely, Sankar Barman, Pabitra Murmu, Pervesh Oraon, Indrajit Handa, Sekhar Mondal, Dut Kr. Mondal and Rana Hembram, are produced before this Court from the J.C. in physical mode.
3. Ld. Public Prosecutor for the State and Ld. Advocates for the accused are present today.
4. PW-12 Dilip Roy is present before this Court.
5. Now, the record is taken up for recording evidence.
6. PW-12 is further cross examined by the Ld. Advocates for the accused persons in full and thereby, he is discharged.
7. As per Gazette Notification dated 15.07.2022, the certified true copies of the deposition of PW-12 dated 15.12.2025 is handed over to all sides after obtaining endorsement in the relevant register.
8. Ld. Public Prosecutor prays for issuance of summons upon CSW-18 for recording his evidence.
9. Issue summons accordingly.
10. Put requisites at once.
11. None moves the petition u/s 311 of Code of Criminal Procedure.
12. Accordingly, the hearing of the petition u/s 311 of Code of Criminal Procedure is adjourned for today.
13. Fix **09.01.2026** for production of the accused persons, evidence of CSW-18 and hearing of the petition u/s 311 of Code of Criminal Procedure.
14. All the accused persons be remanded to J/C till 09.01.2026.
15. At this juncture, Ld. Advocate for the accused Pabitra Murmu has filed a petition praying permitting accused Pabitra Murmu to appear in the UGC-NET and Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan & Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti Recruitment examinations on the specified dates and times at the designated venues; providing him with a proper computer setup and internet access for the CBT from 31st December 2025 to 7th January 2026; directing the Superintendent of Presidency Correctional Home, Alipore, to make all necessary arrangements accordingly, and further permitting him to carry his passport-sized coloured photograph, Aadhaar Card, and admit card to the exam venue(s).
16. Now, the record is taken up for hearing.
17. Heard the Ld. Advocate for the accused at length.
18. Ld. Public Prosecutor has prayed for passing necessary order.
19. Perused the case record.
20. I have carefully perused the petition and the documents annexed with the petition.

21. It appears that the accused person Pabitra Murmu has applied for UGC-NET examination which is going to be held on and from 31st December, 2025 to 7th January, 2026 and Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan & Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti Recruitment Drive 2025 which is going to be held on 10th and 11th January 2026.
22. In view of the above, the Superintendent of Presidency Correctional Home is directed to act within the ambit of Jail Code to make necessary arrangements with regard to appearance/participation of the accused Pabitra Murmu in the above mentioned examinations on the specified date(s) and time after observing all the legal formalities. He is further directed to verify the original admit cards in the name of the accused to facilitate his participation.
23. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of.
24. Let a copy of this order be sent to the Superintendent, Presidency Correctional Home for information and compliance.
