Today is fixed for hearing of the bail application dated 29.01.2026 filed on behalf of accused person, namely Sekhar Mondal.

Received one letter along with bail bond and copy of the solemn order of the Hon'ble Court from the Ld. Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, 2nd Court, Calcutta.

Perused the same and let the same be kept with the record.

Ld. Public Prosecutor is present.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person is also present.

Now the bail petition of accused **Sekhar Mondal** is taken up for hearing.

Heard Ld. Advocate for the accused person and the Ld. Public Prosecutor.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person submits that the accused has been detained in custody for a long time and one of the accused has been granted bail by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta in CRM(M) 2894 of 2025. Ld. Advocate for the accused person further submits that this accused person is on the same footings. So, he prays for bail.

Ld. Public Prosecutor representing the State objects to the bail prayer and submits that the trial of this case is at the advance stage and few witnesses are only left to be examined.

I have gone through the case diary, the bail application as well as the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta in CRM(M) 2894 of 2025 as referred to by the Ld. Advocate for the accused person.

Considering the nature of allegations made, materials in the Case Diary as well as the evidence on record, it appears that granting of bail to the accused at this stage is not proper and prayer for bail is **rejected**.

Case Diary be returned at once.
