Order no. 29 dated 03.02.2026

1. Today is fixed for production of the accused persons, evidence of CSW-19 and hearing of the petition dated 28.08.2025 u/s 311 of the Cr.P.C.
2. Accused person, Rana Hembram, on bail, is present before this court by filing hazira.
3. Accused persons, namely, Sankar Barman, Pabitra Murmu, Pervesh Oraon, Indrajit Handa, Sekhar Mondal and Dut Kr. Mondal, are produced before this Court from the J.C. in physical mode.
4. Ld. Public Prosecutor for the State and Ld. Advocates for the accused are present today.
5. CSW-19 Prosenjit Mondal is present before this Court.
6. Now, the record is taken up for recording evidence.
7. CSW-19 Prosenjit Mondal is examined in chief as PW-14 by the Ld. Public Prosecutor in part.
8. Examination in chief of PW-14 is deferred on prayer of the Ld. Public Prosecutor.
9. During the course of examination, signatures of PW-14 on two certificates u/s 65B of the Indian Evidence Act are marked as Exhibit P-22/1/PW-14 and Exhibit P-23/1/PW-14 respectively, signatures of PW-14 on the seizure list dated 06.07.2024 are marked as Exhibit P-15/3/PW-14 & Exhibit P-15/4/PW-14 and signature of PW-14 on the seizure list dated 10.07.2024 is marked as Exhibit P-24/1/PW-14 (After objection).
10. As per Gazette Notification dated 15.07.2022, the certified true copies of the deposition of PW-14 are handed over to all sides after obtaining endorsement in the relevant register.
11. Ld. Public Prosecutor has filed a petition stating that PW-14 is the extractor of the video footage which were seized in connection with this case. He prays for allowing the prosecution to play the video in open court in presence of both sides for identification by the PW-14.
12. Ld. Advocates for the accused persons pray for passing necessary order.
13. Heard. Perused. Considered.
14. The prayer is allowed for proper adjudication of this case.
15. Accordingly, the prosecution is directed to make necessary arrangements in playing the video footage, as per prayer, on the next date fixed before this court in presence of all sides.
16. Fix **18.02.2026** for appearance & production of the accused persons, further examination in chief of PW-14 and hearing of the petition dated 28.08.2025 u/s 311 of the Cr.P.C.
17. Ld. Advocate for the accused Pabitra Murmu has filed a petition stating that the accused, an undertrial prisoner at Presidency Correctional Home, Alipore, has applied for the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) Paper-II (Classes VI-VIII), scheduled on 07.02.2026 as a 3-hour OMR-based exam and he must appear at a yet-to-be-designated venue with his original Aadhaar card and a passport-sized photo. So, he prays for permission and pass directions to the Superintendent, Presidency Correctional Home to enable his attendance in the said examination.
18. Ld. Public Prosecutor prays for passing necessary order.

19. Heard. Perused the Advance Information of the said examination annexed with the petition.
20. Considered.
21. The prayer is allowed for ends of justice.
22. The Superintendent, Presidency Correctional Home is directed act accordingly within the ambit of the Jail Code.
23. Let a copy of this order along with the photocopy of the Advance Information of Central Teacher Eligibility Test February, 2026 be sent to the Superintendent, Presidency Correctional Home for information and necessary compliance.
24. Issue summons accordingly.
25. Accused, on bail, is as before.
26. Accused persons, namely, Sankar Barman, Pabitra Murmu, Pervesh Oraon, Indrajit Handa, Sekhar Mondal and Dut Kr. Mondal, are remanded to J/C.
27. Let a copy of this order be sent to the Investigating Officer through the Ld. Public Prosecutor for information and necessary compliance.
