Order No. 30 dated 18.02.2026

1. Today is fixed for appearance & production of the accused persons, further examination in chief of PW-14 and hearing of the petition dated 28.08.2025 under section 311 of the Cr.P.C.
2. Accused person, namely, Rana Hembram, on Court bail, is present before this Court by filing hazira.
3. Accused persons, namely, Sankar Barman, Pabitra Murmu, Pervesh Oraon, Indrajit Hansda, Sekhar Mondal and Dut Kr. Mondal are produced before this Court from J.C.
4. Ld. Public Prosecutor is present.
5. Ld. Advocate for the accused persons are also present.
6. PW-14 Prosenjit Mondal is present before this Court.
7. Now the record is taken up for recording evidence.
8. In compliance with order no. 29 dated 03.02.2026 passed by this Court, Ld. Public Prosecutor make marrangement in playing the video footage.
9. At this stage, Ld. Advocate for the accused persons files a petition states that PW-14 cannot be permitted to tender the digital evidence contained in the Pen-Drives as PW-14 is not related to the occurrence and he has no legal authority to exhibit or show off the stored date.
10. Perused the same and let the same be kept with the record.
11. According, PW-14 is discharged without examination.
12. Ld. Advocate for accused Sekhar Mondal files a petition praying for passing order with a direction upon the Jail Authority for making proper arrangement for this accused person to appear in the examination conducted by the West Bengal School Service Examination which is scheduled to be held on 08.03.2026.
13. Heard. Considered. The prayer is **allowed** for the ends of justice.
14. The Superintendent, Presidency Correctional Home is directed to act accordingly within the ambit of Jail Code.
15. Ld. Advocate for the accused Indrajit Hansda files a petition praying for bail.
16. Now the bail petition of accused **Indrajit Hansda** is taken up for hearing.
17. The bail petition is moved.
18. Ld. Advocate for the accused person prays for bail on the following grounds that-
 - (a) he is in custody since 21.07.2024;
 - (b) this accused person is an educated person having certain dignity in the society;

(c) another accused Rana Hembram has been enlarged on bail by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta and

(d) the accused was aged about 23 years at the time of arrest;

19. Ld. Advocate for the accused person submits that this accused person is in custody for a considerable length of time and this accused is on the same footings with that of accused Rana Hembram who was enlarged on bail by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta. So, he prays for bail.

20. Ld. Public Prosecutor opposes the bail prayer of the accused person on the ground that there is direct and specific allegations against the accused/petitioner and the trial is in progress.

21. I have carefully perused the FIR and the materials appearing in the case diary vis-a-vis the evidence on record. It appears that the trial of this case is in progress.

22. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and trend of train of prosecution evidence as well as materials appearing in the case diary, I am not inclined to allow the prayer for bail of this accused person only on the ground that the accused is in custody for a considerable length of time.

23. Accordingly, the prayer for bail of accused person, namely **Indrajit Hansda** stands **rejected**.

24. Fix **05.03.2026** for production & appearance of the accused persons, hearing of the petition filed on 18.02.2026 by the accused persons and hearing of the petition dated 28.08.2025 under section 311 of the Cr.P.C.

25. Accused persons, namely, Sankar Barman, Pabitra Murmu, Pervesh Oraon, Indrajit Hansda, Sekhar Mondal and Dut Kr. Mondal be remanded to J.C till 05.03.2026.

26. Accused person, namely, Rana Hembram, on Court bail, is as before.

27. Case Diary be returned at once.

28. Let a copy of this order along with the photocopy of the petition and annexures filed on behalf of accused Sekhar Mondal be sent to the Superintendent, Presidency Correctional Home for information and necessary compliance.
