Order No.33 dated 05.03.2026

1. Ld. P.O. has been retained on duty during the upcoming process of Special Intensive Revision (S.I.R.) by the Hon'ble Court, Calcutta in view of the order dated 20.02.2026 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ petition (s) Civil Number (s) 1089 of 2025 with W.P. (C) number-126/2026, W.P. (C) number-129/2026 (PIL-W), W.P. (C) number-737/2026 (PIL-W, ), W.P. (C) number-1074/2026 (PIL-W), W.P. (C) number-1088/2026 (PIL-W), W.P. (C) number-1088/2026 (PIL-W), W.P. (C) number-1216/2026 (PIL-W), W.P. (C) number-159/2026 (PIL-W), W.P. (C) number-119/2026 (PIL-W) and Interlocutory applications listed therewith.
2. To-day is fixed for hearing of the bail application dated 20.02.2026 filed on behalf of the accused person namely 6) Dut Kumar Mondal and written objection, if any, in the meantime.
3. To-day is also fixed for production and appearance of the accused persons, hearing of petition filed on 18.02.2026 by the accused persons and hearing of the petition u/s 311 of the Cr. P.C. dated 28.08.2025.
4. The accused persons namely 1) Sankar Barman, 2) Pabitra Murmu, 3) Pervesh Oraon, 4) Indrajit Handa, 5) Sekhar Mondal and 6) Dut Kr. Mondal are produced before this Court from the J.C. in physical mode.
5. The accused person namely 7) Rana Hembram on Court bail is present in Court by filing hazira.
6. Ld. Counsels for the accused persons are present.
7. Ld. P. Ps.-in-charge are present.
8. Now, the record is taken up for hearing of the bail application dated 20.02.2026 filed on behalf of the accused person namely 6) Dut Kumar Mondal.
9. At this juncture, a petition has been filed on behalf of the Prosecution stating that the I.O. is unable to attend Court today along with C.D. due to his urgent official work and therefore an adjournment has been prayed for.
10. Heard both sides.
11. Prayer for an adjournment is considered and allowed.
12. One petition along with a copy of marriage invitation card has been filed on behalf of the accused person namely 7) Rana Hembram praying for allowing him to attend his elder sister's marriage ceremony and also permitting his to stay there for a period of seven days on the ground stated therein.
13. Copy served.

14. Ld. Counsel for the accused person namely 7) Rana Hembram, thereafter, submits that the accused/petitioner is not willing to proceed with the petition and subsequently he not presses the petition dated 05.03.2026 filed today.
15. Accordingly, the petition dated 05.03.2026 filed by the accused, 7) Rana Hembram, stands rejected being not pressed.
16. In view of the above fact, the case is adjourned today for the ends of justice.
17. Fixing **18.03.2026** for production and appearance of the accused persons, hearing of petition filed on 18.02.2026 by the accused persons and hearing of the petition u/s 311 of the Cr. P.C. dated 28.08.2025.
18. To-date i.e. on **18.03.2026** for hearing of the bail application dated 20.02.2026 filed on behalf of the accused person namely 6) Dut Kumar Mondal and written objection, if any, in the meantime.
19. The accused persons are remanded to J.C. till 18.03.2026.
20. The accused person namely Rana Hembram on Court bail is as before.
21. Let a copy of this order be sent to the Investigating Officer through the concerned O/C with a direction to take necessary steps to ensure production of the C.D. on the next date fixed.
