

COMMON ORDER BELOW EXH. 1& PURSIS DATED 13.09.2025

The matter is listed for National Lok Adalat. Today, complainant is present before National Lok Adalat Panel along with his learned Advocate. He is duly identified by his learned advocate. The complainant filed withdrawal pursis and submitted that, the case is amicably settled between the parties. He has no grievance against accused. He does not want to proceed with this case. Thus, the complainant wants to withdraw the present case. The alleged offence punishable under Section 25, 28 & 29 of the Payment and Settlement Act, 2007 is compoundable. There is sufficient ground to permit the complainant to withdraw the complaint, as the matter is amicably settled between the parties and complainant is not having any grievance against the accused. In view of the Award before the Lok Adalat Panel and considering all these aspects, following order is passed.

ORDER

1. This case is disposed off as it is amicably settled between the parties in view of withdrawal pursis.
2. The accused is acquitted of the offence punishable under Section 25, 28 & 29 of the Payment and Settlement Act, 2007 vide section 257 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973/ Section 280 of The Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
3. Bail Bond of the accused if any is/are cancelled.
4. Court fees be refunded as per rules.
