This petition having been finally heard on 06-06-2026 and the court on same day passed the following:-

ORDER

Petition filed u/s. 483 of BNSS.

2. The prosecution allegation is that on 10.05.2026 at 8 PM, while the minor was playing with the son of the accused by riding a cycle and on account of spraining on her leg she sat on the back seat of the autorickshaw of the accused, at that time the accused pressed on her legs and thighs and when she tried to escape, he partially undressed her and pressed on her vagina and thereby committed offences punishable u/s.126(2) and 75 of BNS and Section 4(2),3,8 and 7 of the POCSO Act. The accused was arrested and remanded to judicial custody since 13.05.2026.

3. The accused contended that the allegations levelled against him is baseless. He has no criminal antecedents and his further custody is not required for any purpose. Hence he prays to grant bail.

4. Copy served. The investigating officer filed report opposing the application.

5. Heard both sides. Perused the records.

6. The learned special public prosecutor opposed the bail application. The victim is aged only 8 years and the act of the accused had caused mental agony and trauma to the victim. The investigation is on the

early stage. The allegation is that he sexually assaulted the minor child while she was playing with his son. The offences alleged are grave in nature and there is chance for the accused to intimidate the victim and her family and also to tamper evidence and influence the witnesses. Considering the grave nature of alleged offences and the present stage of investigation, I am not inclined to grant bail to the accused.

In the result, the petition is dismissed.
