Order no. 16 dated 18.02.2026

1. Today is fixed for S/R, appearance and hearing on the point of cognizance.
2. Ld. Special Public Prosecutor representing the Enforcement Directorate is present.
3. Ld. Advocates for the accused Subrata Kundu and Manaswita Ghosh are present.
4. Ld. Special Public Prosecutor has filed the original service returns of the accused person, proposed accused persons/companies nos. 1-18. Perused the same and let it be kept with the record.
5. Ld. Advocate for the accused Subrata Kundu has filed a petition submitting that they have preferred an application being CRR No. 689 of 2026 before the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta challenging the order dated 03.01.2026 passed by this court and the Hon'ble Court has been pleased to stay the proceeding of the order dated 03.01.2026. So, he prays for passing necessary order.
6. Ld. Advocate for the accused Manaswita Ghosh has filed a petition, annexing server copy of an order passed by the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta in CRR 491 of 2026, stating that they have preferred an application before the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta challenging the order dated 03.01.2026 passed by this court and the Hon'ble Court has been pleased to stay the proceeding of the order dated 03.01.2026. He also prays for passing necessary order.
7. Heard the Ld. Advocates for the accused persons.
8. Ld. Special Public Prosecutor for the Enforcement Directorate raises objection.
9. Perused the case record as well as the server copy of the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta in CRR 491 of 2026.
10. The relevant portion of the order of the Hon'ble Court is as follows:

“Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and that the petitioner had made out an arguable case which requires adjudication on merit, let the operation of the order dated 3rd January, 2026 passed by the learned Chief Judge, City Sessions Court, Calcutta be stayed qua the petitioner, Manaswita Ghosh for a period of twelve weeks or until further order, whichever is earlier.”
11. In view of the solemn observation of the Hon'ble Court, the case is adjourned.
12. Fix **22.04.2026** for awaiting direction from the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta in respect of the order on the point of cognizance.
