Order no. 03 dated 18.11.2025

1. Today is fixed for production of the accused person, namely Arun Saraf from the custody of Enforcement Directorate.
2. Accused person Arun Saraf is produced before this Court from the custody of Enforcement Directorate along with medical slip and he is taken into custody.
3. Ld. Special Public Prosecutor representing the Enforcement Directorate is present.
4. Ld. Advocate for the accused person is present.
5. Hazira has been filed on behalf of the complainant.
6. Ld. Special Public Prosecutor for Enforcement Directorate files a petition praying for judicial custody of the accused Sk. Jinnar Ali @ Jinnar Ali for the purpose of thorough and proper investigation of this case.
7. Ld. Advocate for the accused person raises no objection.
8. Heard both sides. The prayer for judicial custody of accused Arun Saraf is allowed in the interest of thorough and proper investigation of this case.
9. Accused Arun Saraf be remanded to J.C till **02.12.2025**.
10. Ld. Special Public Prosecutor for Enforcement Directorate prays for allowing the Investigating Officer of this case and his team to interrogate and record the statement of this accused person u/s 50 of the PML Act, 2002 in the Correctional Home.
11. Heard. Considered. The prayer is allowed to facilitate the works of investigation.
12. The Investigating Officer of this case is at liberty to interrogate and record the statement of this accused person u/s 50 of the PML Act, 2002 in the concerned correctional home in presence of Jail Superintendent but outside the scope and ambit of his hearing and after compliance of all the legal formalities with regard to interrogation inside the correctional home premises and the same is to be done after proper identification of the team of the Officers of Enforcement Directorate.
13. The Superintendent of Presidency Correctional Home is directed to render all cooperation after proper verification of the identity of the team of officers of the investigating agency.
14. Issue custody warrant accordingly.
15. Accused person Arun Saraf be remanded to J.C till 02.12.2025.
16. Fixing **02.12.2025** for production of accused Arun Saraf before this Court from J.C.
17. Ld. Advocate for the accused person files a petition praying for releasing the accused on parole as his wife has delivered a premature baby and both of them are in ICU and as such the presence of this accused is very much required by their side in the hospital.
18. Ld. Special Public Prosecutor for Enforcement Directorate raises vehement objection.
19. Heard both sides.
20. It is reported, with solemn gravity, that the wife of the accused has recently bestowed upon the

world a premature infant. Due to unforeseen and grave medical complications, she now lies in the ICU, her fragile condition enveloped in the shroud of criticality.

21. Relying upon the earnest submission of learned counsel for the accused, and mindful of the inherent human sentiments that transcend mere legal formalities, this Court, presided over by a human soul imbued with empathy, hereby recognizes that the presence of the husband with his wife and the nascent life she bears holds profound sentimental significance—an essence that demands a judicious and compassionate approach.
22. Accordingly, the Superintendent of the Correctional Home is hereby directed to make all necessary arrangements to facilitate the accused's exercise of his sacred right of visitation. Such visits shall be strictly governed by the prescribed time frame as determined by the hospital authorities, ensuring that the human element of familial bonding is preserved even amidst the stern confines of justice.
23. The duration of each visitation shall not, in any circumstance, exceed one hour (1 hour), exclusive of the time consumed in the journey to and from the hospital, herein identified as Neotia Mediplus, Kolkata-17.
24. The Superintendent shall forthwith communicate with the hospital authorities to ascertain the precise timetable established for visits by the patient's family. Adequate provisions for security shall be arranged, ensuring the safe and smooth transit of the accused from the correctional home to the hospital and back, safeguarding the dignity and security of all parties involved.
25. This furlough, granted with a view to uphold the human spirit amidst judicial rigor, shall be valid only for the dates 19th November 2025 and 20th November 2025, within the specified temporal limits.
26. The Superintendent of the Correctional Home shall furnish a detailed report of compliance before this Court on the 21st of November, 2025, so that the judiciary may remain apprised of the faithful execution of this order.
27. The Superintendent of Presidency Correctional Home is directed to take necessary steps in this regard within the ambit and scope of the Jail Code.
28. Let a copy of this order be sent to the Superintendent of Presidency Correctional Home for information.
29. Let a copy of this order be also sent to the Investigating Officer of Enforcement Directorate through Ld. Special Public Prosecutor for information.
