The instant revision has been preferred challenging the order dated 13.05.2026 passed by the Ld. Judicial Magistrate, 16th Court, Calcutta in connection with Case no. CS/637/2012 wherein the Ld. Magistrate kept with the record one petition filed on 13.05.2026 itself thereby fixing 16.06.2026 for awaiting order i.d. necessary order.

The revision has been filed within time.

For the ends of justice, the revision is admitted.

At this stage, another petition has been filed on behalf of the revisionist/complainant thereby stating that there is subsequent development wherein the accused, respondent no.2 herein, filed an application before the Ld. Trial Court on 13.05.2026 showing his incapacity to pay the fine amount of Rs. 10,00,000/- and he prayed for serving out the sentence passed by the Ld. Trial Court and accordingly, he was taken into custody and has been serving the sentence.

Ld. Advocate further submitted that the liability to pay the fine amount is still subsisting and he will take appropriate action/steps before the Ld. Trial Court accordingly.

Since the order impugned has become infructuous due to the subsequent development and the appellant seeks to take appropriate steps. Accordingly, the Criminal Revision is **disposed of** with the liberty to the revisionist to take appropriate steps, if any, before the Ld. Trial Court in accordance with law.

The matter stands disposed of.
