Order no.11 dated 25.06.2025

The record is placed before this Court by a put up petition filed on behalf of accused/petitioner namely Tridip Pal @ Apu Da.

One petition under section 91 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (corresponding to section 88 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is filed by the Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner namely Tridip Pal @ Apu Da.

The Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner files server copy of the order of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta passed in C.R.M (R) 32 of 2025 on 24.06.2025 and also files an undertaking for keeping the same in the case record.

The operative portion of the order of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta passed in C.R.M (R) 32 of 2025 on 24.06.2025 runs as follows :-

“In the said backdrop, this Court is inclined to hold that despite the gravity of the allegations against the petitioner and material that has transpired against him during investigation, the petitioner ought to be released forthwith upon execution of bond under Section 91 of the BNSS in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Tarsem Lal (supra)”.

Heard Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner namely Tridip Pal as well as Ld. Special Public Prosecutor for Enforcement Directorate.

Considered.

In view of the Judgment of the Hon'ble Apex Court in **Tarsem Lal Vs Directorate of Enforcement Jalandhar Zonal Office** reported in **2024 SCC OnLine SC 971** vis-a-vis the order of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta passed in C.R.M (R) 32 of 2025 on 24.06.2025, I am inclined to allow the prayer of the accused/petitioner, namely Tridip Pal @ Apu Da.

So, the accused/petitioner, namely **Tridip Pal @ Apu Da** be released on furnishing a bond of **Rs. 10,000/-** with two sureties of **Rs. 5,000/- each** subject to the satisfaction of Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Calcutta i.d J.C till date i.e. on 30.06.2025 with a condition to appear before this Court on every date of hearing and shall not tamper with evidence or intimidate witnesses in any manner whatsoever.

If the accused/petitioner availed of the opportunity of bail to date (**30.06.2025**) for appearance of the accused/petitioner.

Let a copy of this order be sent to the Enforcement Directorate through Ld. Special Public Prosecutor for information.
