After passing of the above order, one copy of judgment dated 26.08.2025 passed by the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta in connection with CRA (DB) 137 of 2025 is received from the Hon'ble High Court, Criminal Section, Appellate Side vide Memo no.4354 Cr. (A) dated 03.09.2025.

Perused the copy of judgment dated 26.08.2025 wherein the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta has been pleased to observe as follows:

*“Accordingly, we direct that the appellant shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.50, 000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Kolkata subject to the condition that the appellant shall appear before the Trial Court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate the witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever. The appellant will not enter into the jurisdiction of the local police station, save and except for attending the learned Trial Court on all the dates specified for hearing. Appellant will inform the Officer-in-charge of the local police station as well as the Officer-in-charge of the police station under whose jurisdiction he resides. In the event the appellant fails to appear before the Trial Court without any justifiable cause, the Trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel the bail of the appellant without further reference to this Court.*

*The prayer for bail of the appellant is allowed.*

*CRA (DB) 137 of 2025 is allowed.”*
