Considering the voluntary surrender of the accused and the nature of the alleged offence, I think that it would not be proper to detain her in custody. Hence, the prayer for bail of accused Nilima Sarkar is allowed.

Accused Nilima Sarkar may find bail of Rs.5,000/- with one registered surety of like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate-I, Calcutta.

At this stage, an application under Section 205 of the CrPC is filed on behalf of the accused no.3.
