This application U/s. 483 BNSS for grant of regular bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Vipin Choudhary @ Babban** is placed before me in terms of order No. 4010-4033 Judl /Bail /North /RC /2026, dated 31.01.2026 of Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge, North, Rohini Courts, Delhi.

Ld. Counsel for applicant/accused submits that applicant/accused is in JC since 22.12.2025 and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that a bare perusal of the FIR in question would make it evident that there is an unexplained delay of 8 hours in registration of the FIR which itself creates serious doubts on the story of the complainant. It is further submitted that nothing incriminating was recovered either from the applicant/accused or at his instance. It is further submitted that applicant/accused is not named in the FIR and the allegations of firing are not against the applicant/accused. It is further submitted that investigation qua applicant/accused has already been completed in as much as no

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furthe police custody was even sought by the police officails after initial custody of 2 days. It is further submitted that in the present case co-accused persons have already been granted bail. It is further submitted that no application of applicant/accused is pending either before any other Court including Superior Courts. It is prayed that above said application may kindly be allowed on

On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly opposed the bail application and submitted that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be dismissed.

This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

Briefly stated, the present FIR bearing no. 589/2025 has been registered at PS Alipur U/s. 109(1) / 125 / 324(4) / 329(4) / 62 /351(3)/79/191(2)/191(3)/190/311/3(5) BNS & U/s. 25/27 Arms Act. Applicant/accused **Vipin Choudhary @ Babban** is in JC since 22.12.2025 i.e. for a period of about 1 ½ months. Investigation qua him has been completed. No further custodial interrogation is required. Charge-sheet has been filed before the

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Court of Ld. JMFC Concerned. Trial shall take time. Further, co-accused persons namely Abhilash Pathak, Sahil Verma, Vishal Yadav, Ravi Sharma, Durgesh Jha, Himanshu @ Monu, Anubhav Singh, Rahul @ Baccha, Sachin and Krishna Goswami have already been enlarged on bail, therefore, it is ordered that applicant/accused **Vipin Choudhary @ Babban** be released on bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 20,000/- with one surety in the like amount subject to the satisfaction of **Ld. JMFC/Ld.Link JMFC/Ld. Duty JMFC as well as following conditions:-**

- (i) Applicant/accused is directed not to threaten prosecution witnesses in any manner or tamper with evidence or indulge in any other criminal activity in future;
- (ii) Applicant/accused shall not commit similar offences in future. In case, it is prima facie brought to the notice of the Court that the applicant/accused is violating the said conditions, the bail granted to him shall be liable to be cancelled on an application of investigating agency in this regard.

The bail application is disposed of accordingly. Nothing stated herein shall tantamount to any expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

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Application stands disposed of. Bail application file be
consigned to record room. Copy of the order be given dasti.
