Record is put up on the prayer of the Ld. Chief P.P. who moves a petition praying for necessary order to cure some typographical error in order No.30 dated 21.06.2025.

It is stated that in order dated 21.06.2025 it was inadvertently observed that no written objection has been filed against the petition dated 21.03.2025 disputing the claim that the I.O. did not return the seized alams in respect of seizure list No.A including two mobile phones, original I D Card, cash amounting to Rs.2,68,585/- etc. It is claimed that the prosecution duly filed an objection against the application filed by the accused.

Perused the available materials on record. I do not find any written objection filed by the prosecution against petition dated 21.03.2025. One undated report and one report dated 11.03.2025 were filed by the I.O. in respect of order No.27 dated 12.02.2025 but no written objection was filed by the prosecution against petition dated 21.03.2025. Since there was no typographical error in order dated 21.06.2025, the instant petition filed by the prosecution merits rejection. Accordingly, the petition is rejected.
