Heard. Considered the petition u/s 305 Cr.PC is hereby allowed the Ld. Advocate Mr. Abhishek Bagal on behalf of accused No.1 is permitted to represent the accused No.1 on condition that the representative of accused No.1 shall appear before the Court during consideration of plea, examination u/s 313 Cr.PC, on the date of delivery of Judgment and as when so directed by this Court.

Another petitions u/s 205 Cr.PC is filed on behalf of the accused Nos.2, 3 and 4.

The petitions u/s 205 Cr.PC filed by the accused Nos.2, 3 and 4 are taken up for hearing in presence of the Ld. Advocates for both sides.

Considered the nature of allegation. It is contended that the accused Nos.2, 3 and 4 are permanent residents of Telangana and it is difficult for them to present on every date because it is very far from Kolkata. In view of the nature of allegations, I am of the opinion that personal appearance of the accused Nos.2, 3 and 4 on all dates as may be fixed by this Court in this case may not be necessary if they are represented by their pleader. Accordingly, the prayer u/s 205 Cr.PC is allowed and the Ld. Advocate on behalf of accused Nos.2, 3 and 4 namely Mr. Abhishek Bagal is permitted to represent the accused Nos.2, 3 and 4 on condition that these accused persons must present themselves before this Court whenever it is so directed by this Court and also on the dates of hearing of plea, examination u/s 313 of Cr.PC and at the time of delivery of judgment.

The petitions are thus disposed of.
