Today is fixed for plea.

The complainant is present.

The accused namely Ajit Kumar Singh is present with his Ld. Advocate.

The record is now taken up for plea.

Perused the record.

Allegation against the accused person is that he, in discharge of his liability towards the loan installment, he endorsed Electronic Fund Transfer amounting to Rs.46,486/- from his account through Electronic Fund Transfer but is was dishonoured on 03.04.2022 on the ground of "Balance Insufficient". On 06.05.2022 the complainant issued a demand notice through his Ld. Advocate claiming the amount of Rs.46,486/- and the notice to that effect was duly received by accused person but the accused person has failed to pay the sum of Rs.46,486/- being the amount covered by the aforesaid Electronic Fund Transfer.

Accordingly, accused was examined under section 251 of Cr. P.C for committing the offence punishable under section 25 of the Payment and Settlement Systems Act 2007 and substance of the allegation to that effect that "you, in discharge of your obligation to pay you endorsed Electronic Fund Transfer amounting to Rs.46,486/- from your account through Electronic Fund Transfer but is was dishonoured on 03.04.2022 on the ground of "Balance Insufficient". On 06.05.2022 the complainant issued a demand notice through his Ld. Advocate claiming the amount of Rs.46,486/- and the notice to that effect was duly received by you but you have failed to pay the sum of Rs.46,486/- being the amount covered by the aforesaid Electronic Fund Transfer" is read over and explained to the accused person to which he pleads not guilty by saying "Main nirdosh hun".
