

Order dated:

Record is put up today by way of petition.

One substitution petition is filed by Ld. Advocate for the Complainant along with relevant annexures, praying for permission to pass necessary order to substitute new authorised representative in place of the earlier one.

Heard Ld. Advocate for the Complainant.

Perused the materials available with the case record.

This Court is of the view that if the instant substitution petition is allowed, defence will not be prejudiced, nor the status the instant case shall be altered.

Hence, the petition so filed on behalf of the Complainant stands allowed and present authorised representative is permitted to represent the Complainant Company.

Now, another petition is filed under section 257 Cr.P.C. / 280 BNSS praying for permission to withdraw the instant case..

Heard. Ld. Advocate. Perused the materials available with the case record.

Statement of the authorised representative is recorded on oath.

Since the matter has been amicably settled by and between the parties, this Court finds no cogency to drag the case further.

Hence, it is,

Ordered

*That the case be **withdrawn** by the complainant under section 257 Cr.P.C.280 BNSS
