Today is fixed for evidence of CSW 1.

Accused is present.

The Ld. APP and the Ld. Advocate of the accused are present.

The Ld. Advocate of the accused submitted that the evidence should be closed in respect of CSW 1 as she did not turn up after getting intimation of summons from her grand mother.

On the contrary, the Ld. APP submitted that fresh summons or even warrant upon the CSW 1 may be issued.

On perusal of the record it is found that there are reports of Police with regard to the summons of the CSW 1 being dated 24.04.2022 and 13.07.2022.

The report dated 24.04.2022 shows that the father of the CSW 1 namely, Tapan Majumdar refused to take the summons of her daughter and report dated 13.07.2022 shows that one Roma Majumdar of 80 years age being the grand mother of the CSW 1 had received the summons on behalf of CSW 1. But now the witness CSW 1 did not turn up.

As the provision of Section 64 of Cr.P.C, this court is of the view that no WWA should be issued as the said summons was received by a female and not by an adult male.

Therefore, this court is of the view that fresh summons leads to be issued upon CSW 1 along with her mobile number as mentioned in the written complaint.

Let a fresh summons be issued upon CSW 1 along with her mobile number and the issuing officer should make contact with the CSW 1 in her contact number and also to reflect the same in his report, if any.

Let a copy of this order be sent along with the summons for necessary compliance by the Police.
