Today is fixed for 313 of Cr.P.C., argument and judgment.

Since no incriminating materials appeared against the accused person during prosecution evidence, his personal examination u/s 313 of Cr.P.C. is hereby dispensed with.

The accused person has declined to adduce any evidence on his behalf. Hence, DW is closed.

One petition u/s 353(6) of Cr.P.C has been filed on behalf of the accused to pronounce judgment in his absence which is considered and allowed.

Judgment is pronounced in the open court. It is written in separate sheets of paper.

Let the same be kept with the record.

As per judgment, it is,

Ordered

that the sole accused person is found not guilty to the charge u/s 465/467/468/474 of the IPC and he is acquitted under Section 248(1) of the Cr.P.C. The accused person is hereby discharged from their bail bond/s, if any; and set at liberty forthwith. Inform the concerned Surety/ies.

Seized articles, if any, be disposed of as per law.

Let a copy of judgment be forwarded to the District Magistrate and DLSA for due intimation to the victim. Victim has a right to prefer an Appeal under proviso to section 408 of Cr.P.C and if necessary, to avail free legal assistance through the legal services authorities concern to prefer and prosecute such Appeal.
