Today is fixed for plea.

Complainant is present.

The accused is present with his Ld. Advocate.

The record is now taken up for plea.

Perused the record.

Allegation against the accused person is that he, in discharge of his obligation to the complainant, issued a cheque being Cheque No. "928091" dated 22.06.2022 amounting to Rs.1,77,841/- of State Bank of India, Panikoili Jajpur, Odisha to the complainant, who presented the said cheque for encashment at ICICI Bank Limited, Rasoi Court Branch, Kolkata. But the aforesaid cheque was dishonoured due to "Funds Insufficient" in the account of accused on 29.06.2022. On 22.07.2022 the complainant issued a notice through his Ld. Advocate claiming the aforesaid cheque amounts and the notice to that effect was duly received by accused person but till date the loan is not repaid.

Accordingly, it is read over to the Ld. Advocate for the accused person under section 251 of Cr. P.C to the effect that "the accused, issued a cheque being Cheque No. "928091" dated 22.06.2022 amounting to Rs.1,77,841/- of State Bank of India, Panikoili Jajpur, Odisha to the complainant, who presented the said cheque for encashment at ICICI Bank Limited, Rasoi Court Branch, Kolkata. But the aforesaid cheque was dishonoured due to "Funds Insufficient" in your account on 29.06.2022. On 22.07.2022 the complainant issued a notice through his Ld. Advocate claiming the aforesaid cheque amounts and the notice to that effect was duly received by you but till date the loan is not repaid" is read over and explained to the accused person to which he pleads not guilty by saying "Ami Nirdosh".

Hence, trial proceeded accordingly.
