to discharge your pre-existing liabilities and when the said cheque was deposited for its encashment, it was returned as dishonoured due to ‘Funds Insufficient’ and therefore, the complainant sent one demand notice on 03.11.2021 by registered post which was deemed to be properly served upon you and despite of proper service of notice upon you, you did not make payment within stipulated period of time and that you thereby committed the offence u/s 138 of N.I Act” to which, he pleaded not guilty by saying “ami nirdosh ” and claimed to be tried.

Subsequently complainant has filed one petition u/s 143A of N.I.Act. Copy served and objected to.

Let the same be kept with the record.
