ORDER

1. File put up before me as learned Presiding Officer is
availing earned leave w.e.f. 01.06.2026 to 07.06.2026.
2. Police record has been produced by ASI Nirmal Singh
No.1515/BTL, Police Station Sekhwan.
3. Heard on the bail application.
4. Briefly stated that it has been mentioned in the bail
application that FIR has been registered against the law and facts. No
offence has been committed by the applicant. Name of applicant
Gagandeep Singh is only mentioned in the general diary. Father's
name is not mentioned. The applicant is in custody since 21.04.2026.
Prayer for grant of bail has been made.

5. Ms. Anita Kumari, learned counsel for applicant submitted that applicant is not named in the FIR. Father's name of the applicant is not mentioned in the DDR or secret information. No recovery was effected from the applicant. The applicant is in custody since 21.04.2026. Upon this, prayer has been made that bail application may be allowed.

6. On the other hand, the learned APP for the State submitted that three unknown persons had snatched 2100 US dollars and motorcycle from complainant Jaideep Singh. The police received secret information on 14.03.2026, pursuant to which, accused Malkit Singh was arrested on 14.03.2026. Applicant Gagandeep Singh was arrested on 21.04.2026. Another accused Harpreet Singh is yet to be arrested. Justin Masih was nominated as accused vide DDR No. 17 dated 17.03.2026 on the basis of disclosure statement made by accused Malkit Singh that stolen motorcycle was given to Justin Masih. Accused Justin Masih is yet to be arrested. The motorcycle used by the accused at the time of occurrence was recovered from accused Malkit Singh. The same was also found to be stolen. Applicant Gagandeep Singh stated that Rs.2000/- in Indian currency was given to him by accused Harpreet Singh. There is one more case registered against applicant under NDPS Act. Upon this, prayer for dismissal of bail application has been made.

7. I have heard the respective contentions of learned counsel for the applicant, learned APP for the State and have gone through

the record of case titled as State of Punjab versus Malkit Singh and another bearing CIS No. CHI-254-2026 pending in the Court of Ms. Baljinder Kaur, Ld. JMIC, Batala, carefully.

8. The FIR was registered on the basis of statement of complainant Jaideep Singh, who stated that he and Bahadar Singh were going on motorcycle bearing registration No.PB-08-DO-4131 and when they were a little ahead of Randhawa Niwas Dera Naushera Majja Singh, then at about 4:10 pm, three persons came on motorcycle, who brought their motorcycle in front of motorcycle of complainant and stopped them. The person sitting on the back of motorcycle pointed out a pistol at Bahadar Singh and asked him to hand over whatever in his possession. Bahadar Singh has 2100 US dollar, which were taken. The second person sitting on the motorcycle snatched motorcycle and mobile phone of the complainant. The accused while going told that mobile is not of their use and threw the mobile phone on the kacha rasta. Action be taken.

9. On 14.03.2026 secret information was received by the police, pursuant to which Malkit Singh, Harpreet Singh and Gagandeep Singh were nominated as accused vide DDR No. 20 dated 14.03.2026. Accused Malkit Singh was arrested and was got identified from the complainant through video conferencing. Malkit Singh made disclosure statement, pursuant to which, motorcycle make Platina bearing registration No.PB-18-S-115 was recovered. On 17.03.2026 Malkit Singh made statement that stolen motorcycle

bearing registration No.PB-08-DO-4131 was handed over to Justin Masih. Justin Masih was nominated as accused vide DDR No. 17 dated 17.03.2026. Accused Gagandeep Singh was arrested on 21.04.2026, who was got identified from the complainant through video conferencing. Applicant Gagandeep Singh disclosed that he was present at the time of snatching and Malkit Singh had given motorcycle to Justin Masih. Pistol used at the time of occurrence was of Harpreet Singh. Gagandeep Singh was given Rs.2000/- in Indian currency, which has been used by him for drugs.

10. No doubt FIR has been registered against unknown persons, yet it has to be noted. Applicant Gagandeep Singh was got identified from the complainant. It has to be noted that 2100 US dollars and motorcycle have been snatched from the complainant and his friend by pointing the pistol. Applicant Gagandeep Singh was present along with two other persons, who had on stolen motorcycle and snatched 2100 US dollars and motorcycle.

11. Keeping in view the grave of offences, regular bail does not deserve to be given to the applicant-accused and the present bail application is hereby dismissed. Trial Court record along with copy of this order be returned. Police record be also returned. Bail application file be sent to the Court concerned for its consignment.
