Today is fixed for appearance and supply of copy.

Accused person is present.

Accused person receives the copy U/S. 230 BNSS.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person filed a petition on behalf of the accused person stating that the accused has received the charge sheet along with some other documents containing altogether 17 pages in which the last page of the charge sheet containing column numbers 15 to 20 are illegible and prayed for a legible copy.

On going through the final form/ report I find that the para 15, para 19 and para 20 do not contain anything. The para 16 contains the brief facts of the case and the original copy lying in the court record also does not have a very clear picture as the print out is lighter in shade but I find that the said facts of the case is available from the FIR format (Para 12) and also from the original FIR. Regarding para 17 its simply written "No". The para 18 shows a date as 05.11.2025 which is clearly legible and there are nothing else.

The Ld. Advocate has been shown the original copy lying in the court and has also been apprised that a further xerox from this part will also not come proper. He insisted on getting its scanned by himself which the court did not allow since it is not permissible in law. The para 16 about which the Ld. Advocate has objection is the brief fact of the case and that is available from the FIR copy and also from the printed FIR form. So, it appears that the accused person merely to drag the case, has filed this petition.

However, for the ends of justice, IO is directed to supply legible copy of last page of charge sheet.

Let a copy of this order be sent to IO for necessary compliance.
