J U D G M E N T

(18/04/2024)

1. The accused is charged for the offences U/Sec. 457, 380 of Indian Penal Code.
2. The accused is produced today in court through video conferencing mode. Accused voluntarily pleaded guilty to the charge. It appears that, the plea of the accused is voluntary. Hence, the plea is accepted.
3. Heard the accused on the point of sentence. The accused submitted that, his economic condition is not sound and his family is dependent on him. The accused prayed that minimum punishment may be imposed.
4. The prosecution could not show that, the accused has criminal antecedents. Considering nature of the offence and the circumstances it will be just and proper to pass the following order.

ORDER

1. Accused viz. Satish Ramesh Chavan is convicted vide Sec. 241 of Cr.P.C. for the offence punishable U/Sec. 457 of Indian Penal Code and sentenced to suffer Rigorous Imprisonment for 02 (Two) months and to Pay fine of ₹ 100/- (One Hundred) in default of payment of fine accused is sentenced to suffer Simple Imprisonment for 01 (One) Day.
2. Accused viz. Satish Ramesh Chavan is convicted vide Sec. 241 of Cr.P.C. for the offence punishable U/Sec. 380 of Indian Penal Code and sentenced to suffer Rigorous Imprisonment for 02 (Two) months and to Pay fine of ₹ 100/- (One Hundred) in default of payment of fine accused is sentenced to suffer Simple Imprisonment for 01 (One) Day.
3. The accused is entitled to get benefit of set off, as per the provisions of Sec.428 of Cr.P.C.
4. Both sentences shall run concurrently.
5. The seized muddemal property be returned to its lawful owner, as per rule, after appeal period is over.
6. Copy of Judgment be given to the accused free of cost.
