Ld. Advocate for the accused person namely, Aswini Gupta is present today and files a bail petition for praying bail and submits that the accused person will appear on each and every future date.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person, namely Anarelal Gupta has prayed to allow the accused to appear through Video Conference vide mobile No. 9432592920 (screen shot attached herewith) stating that the accused is bed ridden and unable to walk. Medical documents have been filed to substantiate the same.

Considered. Prayer is allowed

Ld. Advocate for the accused persons moves the bail petition for the accused person namely Anarelal Gupta aged about 90 years, seriously ill and mostly bed ridden.

On perusal of the record it appears that both the accused persons were absconding as per charge sheet.

Ld. APP is present and raises formal objection.

I have heard submissions of Ld. Advocate for the parties, perused the case record, medical documents produced on behalf of accused person and bail petition.

Considering the age (90 years) and health condition of the accused person, namely Anarelal Gupta may be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs.2000/- (Rupees two thousand) with one Registered Surety, in default, to Judicial Custody.
