Considering that accused Ved Prakash was charge-sheeted without arrest during investigation and the law laid down in Satender Antil Vs. CBI, said accused is admitted to bail on furnishing of bail bonds in the sum of Rs.30,000/- with one surety in the like amount each subject to following conditions:

1. That he shall not indulge into similar offence or any offence in the event of release on bail.
2. That he shall not tamper with the evidences in any manner or influences any of the witnesses in case.
3. That in case of change of his residential address, he shall intimate the court and the IO about the same, and
4. That he shall cooperate with the investigation and appear before the IO as and when called for the purpose of investigation.
5. That he shall keep his mobile switched on at all times and give his correct mobile number to the IO.
6. That he shall regular appear before this court on each and every date of hearing.
7. The accused shall not leave the country without prior permission of the court.

Personal bonds furnished. Let the surety bonds be furnished by NDOH.

Put up for further proceedings as per law on 10.09.2026.
