STATE Vs. DEEPAK KUMAR DAS

This is an application u/s 483 BNSS moved on behalf of applicant/accused Deepak Kumar Das for grant of interim bail.

Arguments heard.

It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the accused/applicant that accused has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that primary reason for filing of interim bail application is that the mother of accused is suffering from medical ailment i.e. Falaria in which the leg of the person gets swollen excessively and if not treated on time, the mother of applicant can die of this deadly disease. It is further submitted that doctors have told the mother of applicant/accused for surgery and if same is not done on time then she can die due to this serious medical ailment. It is further submitted that medical documents of mother of applicant/accused is annexed with present interim bail application. It is further submitted that doctor has given 24.01.2026 as the date of surgery and she is now admitted in Rama Health care Hospital. It is further submitted that nobody is available for taking care of his mother and for arrangement of funds for treatment of her mother. It is further submitted that applicant/accused is ready to abide by all the conditions which may be imposed upon him and therefore, it is requested that he may be granted interim bail.

On the other hand, Ld. Addl. PP for the State has opposed the interim bail application on the ground that total 152 KG of Ganja has been recovered in the present case. It is further submitted that offence is grave in nature and therefore, his interim bail may not be considered.

IO has confirmed that as per doctor's report mother of applicant/accused is under treatment in Rama Health Care Hospital. It is further submitted that she has been suggested to admit on 24.01.2026 whereas no tentative date is fixed for surgery. It is further submitted that earlier also mother of applicant/accused had undergone a surgery in September 2025.

Submissions considered. Record perused.

Medical document filed with the application has been perused.

Rama Health Care Hospital is in Siliguri, West Bengal and no physical verification of the condition of mother of applicant/accused and the documents has been done by the IO. Further, wife of applicant/accused is also available to look after the mother of applicant/accused. Interim bail can be considered only in extremely urgent and exceptional circumstances. No such circumstances are made out in the present case. The personal or family problems of the accused/applicant cannot be considered for the purpose of interim bail.

Accordingly interim bail application of applicant/accused Deepak Kumar Das is disposed of as dismissed.

Copy of the order be given dasti.

No observations are made on the merits of the case.
