Both the accused on court bail are present by filing hazira.

The accused **are** informed that **they are** entitled to have the case inquired into or tried by another Municipal Magistrate.

The accused **are** further asked that whether **they have** any objection to further proceedings before the present Senior Municipal Magistrate who took cognizance of the offence.

The accused have **thereby** been given the right to be tried by a Municipal Magistrate other than the one who took cognizance of the offence.

The accused **have** expressed desire not to be tried by any other Municipal Magistrate and prayed for to be tried by this Court.

Hence, the case record is kept in this Court for inquiry, trial and disposal.

The copies of police report and relevant documents or relevant extract thereof forwarded to this Court with the police report under section 173 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 are furnishing to the accused, free of cost, in accordance with the provisions of section 207 of the Cr.P.C.

The case record is taken up for framing of charge.

Considered the police report and the documents sent with it under section 173, Cr.P.C..

Examined the accused.

Heard both sides.

Upon such consideration, examination and hearing the Court is of opinion that there is ground for presuming that the accused have committed offence triable under Chapter XIX, Cr.P.C which could be adequately punished by this Court and accordingly, charge punishable **under sections 401A, 392 and 618 read with sections 584 and 610** of the Kolkata Municipal Corporation Act, 1980 and **section 452** of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is framed in writing against the accused in a separate charge form which is kept with the record.

The said charge is then read over and explained to the accused in Bengali and are asked whether they pleaded guilty of the offence charged or claimed to be tried to which both of them they pleaded not guilty by saying “Nirdoshi” and claimed to be tried.

To 30/03/2021 for evidence of CSWs in terms of the provisions of section 242, Cr.P.C..

The prosecution is directed to produce its evidence in support of its case.

BC – II is directed to issue summons upon the CSWs at once.

The accused are directed to remain present on the next date.
